

# Introduction to the SagePay Installation

First of all, thank you very much for the purchase of the SagePay Module and the confidence you thereby placed in us.

Before you can begin with the installation you require the access data for the administration interface of SagePay. This will be sent to you directly by SagePay and consists of Merchant name, User name and password. With this data you can then log into your account under <https://test.sagepay.com/mysagepay/loginpage.msp>.

## Configuration Back-end (Sage Pay)

In order to configure the module you must carry out a small but very important configuration in your Sage Pay account. Log into your account under <https://test.sagepay.com/mysagepay/loginpage.msp> and go to Settings > Valid IP's and insert the IP address of your server in the following format:

- IPAddress: IP Address of your server
- Subnet mask: 255.255.255.255

## Module Installation in the Shop (Magento Sage Pay)

### Configuration of the Main Module

Go to System > Configuration and select your Payment Service Provider in the left configuration bar.

**Import: the data entered here must be identical to that in the back-end of your PSP (see above).**

### Configuration of the Payment Methods

Go to System > Configuration > Payment Methods. You can then activate all payment methods supported by your payment package with your PSP and configure them according to your preferences.

## Module Processing (Sage Pay)

- Go to the order menu and click on "New"
- Insert the customer's name under "Search customer" and click on "Select" or create a new customer
- Enter the required product into the box "Search products" and add it into the cart
- Choose Euro as currency
- Under Overview > Payments you must select SagePay Payment and then click on "Transmit order"
- Click on "Debit the customer"
- Enter the payment data of the customer
- By going to the orders menu you can see if the transaction has succeeded and the money been charged
